Directions for Use

COOKING INSTRUCTIONS (for 1 kg of frozen mashed potatoes = 4 to 5 persons) Cook from frozen. In a microwave oven (10 to 16 minutes): Pour the content of the bag in an adapted dish. Add 400 ml of milk, a little bit of salt, pepper and nutmeg and a knob of butter and cover the dish. Heat for: 10 to 12 min. at 1000 W 12 to 14 min. at 750 W 14 to 16 min. at 650 W. Stir halfway the cooking time. In a saucepan (10 to 12 minutes): Pour the content of the bag in an adapted dish. Add 400 ml of milk, a little bit of salt, pepper and nutmeg and a knob of butter. Heat 10 to 12 minutes and stir regularly. **SUGGESTION:** Try Lutosa Mashed Potatoes cooked crusty. After preparing the mashed potatoes described as above add an egg yolk, mix thoroughly, spread grated cheese on top, or breadcrumbs and then place under the grill for $\pm$ 5 min.
